

HEALTH & SAFETY AT EARLY BIRDS PLAYHOUSE

The health and safety of everyone in our community are top priorities at Early Birds Playhouse. Our health & safety protocols meet and often exceed industry and state standards and are designed to keep all students, families and teachers safe.



ILLNESS REQUIREMENT:

If a child or teacher exhibits a fever of 100.4° or higher that person will be excused from all center activities and should stay home until fever (and symptom) free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medicine. This policy and duration of absence also apply to vomiting or diarrhea.



HEALTH CHECK:

Monitoring and assessing children in our care is an important part of our health checks. Children must be symptom free at drop-off. If a child exhibits behavior not typical, parents will be notified.



BUILDING ACCESS:

Accessing the interior of the building is limited to students and staff. For the convenience and safety of everyone, efficient pick-up and drop-off will take place in the lobby.



CLEANING & SANITIZING:

All toys, materials & surfaces are cleaned and sanitized daily. Spot sanitizing and cleaning happens on an as needed basis during the day.



PROPER HAND WASHING:

A high priority is placed on hand washing. Upon arrival and throughout the day, hand washing and proper technique is practiced and encouraged regularly and after messy or outdoor play.



MEALS, SNACKS & ESSENTIALS:

We are a full-service center where all meals, snacks, diapers, wipes, sunscreen and more are provided for all children enrolled at the school.
